DIVISION II/III ALL-STARS BEAT DIVISON I SQUAD, 6-3, IN NEIBA ALL-STAR GAME AT FENWAY PARK

BOSTON – The Division II and III all-stars from across New England topped a University squad filled with Division I all-stars, 6-3, in the NEIBA New England College All-Star Game held at Fenway Park on June 14.

The College Division got on the board first when Southern Connecticut junior Karl Derbacher led off the game with an opposite field home run to go up, 1-0, on the University squad.

The Division II/III all-stars added two more in the second and upped their led to 6-0 with a three-run Monster shot off the bat of Franklin Pierce's Kevin Renaud.

The Division I all-stars came back for three in the sixth, and brought the tying run to the plate in the seventh, but couldn't narrow the deficit as the College Division held on for the 6-3 win.

Trinity College's Mike Regan picked up the win with the University of Hartford's Chris Greiner taking the loss.

The 2008 win was the second straight and the fourth in the last six for the Division II/III all-stars, who outhit their Division I counterparts, 7-5, in this year's contest.
